2019 *DISCOVER: New Musicals* Submission Guidelines

Baayork Lee, Artistic Director of National Asian Artists Project (NAAP), is pleased to announce the 6th Annual ***DISCOVER: New Musicals***, a presentation of staged-readings of new short or one-act musicals performed by casts of professional Asian-American actors in New York City. This program complements NAAP's *REDISCOVER* series, in which casts perform classic or established works of the American musical theater. This year's *DISCOVER: New Musicals* will take place May 6, 2019 at Theatre 315 (located at 315 West 47th Street, at 7:30pm).

NAAP will fund, produce, and invite industry professionals to the musicals presented. In the interest of continuing to also develop artistic leaders, NAAP will provide a director for each selected piece from their roster of experienced directors.

Project Eligibility: It is **NOT** necessary for the writers/composers to be of Asian descent. ***Also, the musical's style, theme, and subject matter are open, but the piece should be able to be realized with an Asian-American cast.*** Only musicals of less than 30 minutes in length will be considered. **Please indicate the running time of your submission.** The submission may be excerpted from a longer musical, but the excerpt must feel complete in itself.

Application Process: The one-page application is available at www.naaproject.org. Please mail the completed application with 3 copies of your script and 1 demo CD of the work with vocals; as well as emailed electronically (pdf and mp3) to Discover@NAAPProject.org. If the submission for consideration is an excerpt, then submit *only the excerpt*. Full-length shows will not be considered. Professional demos are not required, but keep in mind poor audio can affect how a work is understood. Mail to NAAP's administrative office:

Evaluative Criteria: Ms. Lee will chair a panel of musical theater professionals in the selection process. Submissions will be evaluated based upon the following criteria:

- Overall artistic merit – artistic quality of the book, lyrics, and music
- Storytelling – does the narrative feel complete?
- Originality – is the writing team's aesthetic voice unique?
- Application to NAAP's Mission – can NAAP and a cast of Asian-Americans fully realize the work?

Submission Limits: No more than 2 different submissions per credited author. If a writer/composer has multiple works they wish to be considered, please limit the number of submissions to two.

Application Timeline: Completed applications (available online at www.naaproject.org) **must be delivered by Friday February 15, 2019 at 5:00 PM EST**. The selected projects will be announced no later than March 10, 2019. Auditions will be held in early April and rehearsals will begin shortly thereafter, as determined by individual projects.
